Residents, relatives and those working within the elderly care sector.

The aim of this project is to make IT available to the residents, relatives and staff in the elderly care sector.

Linköping municipality elderly care sector has recently started a pilot project involving so-called computer kiosks which are located at two elderly care centres. The computers can be utilised by the residents, relatives and staff. These groups are not normally regular users of IT systems.

Interest for this undertaking is growing; however, before this project is expanded it is necessary to know what experiences other cities and regions have had. Therefore we would like to come into contact with local/regional authorities/actors involved with, or have responsibility for, elderly care. We are interested in care homes which provide IT facilities for the residents, relatives and staff allowing them, on a regular basis, to participate in community activities and debates, make use of e-services etc and also use this as a means of communication.

Depending on interest, a cooperation project between various cities can be developed within the framework of an EU Programme, for example Europe for Citizens, Lifelong Learning Programme (Leonardo da Vinci or Grundtvig).
