
EUROEMPLEO-INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION PROGRAM IN EMPLOYMENT

PROJECT: COMPARATIVE RESEARCH: LOCAL ACTION FOR EMPLOYMENT IN THE EU. SYNERGIES AND TRANSFERABILITY OF RESULTS.

PRESENTATION:

The Diputación Provincial de Sevilla leads, long, running and promoting actions in the territory for the promotion of employment. The philosophy behind these actions is the firm belief that, from the local one has a real and closer knowledge of the issues and trends that are occurring in regional economies. On this basis, are being promoted and implemented actions / programs that develop active employment policies and improving the employability of people in different territories.

The typology of these actions has been and is currently mixed. Similarly, the results obtained with different actions are also very different and in some cases has not been evaluated beyond the immediate termination of an action, the impact they may have had and what has resulted from changes in market local work.

The crisis situation in recent times has made the Local Institutions redouble their efforts in the line of action for employment, allocating resources and creating infrastructure for it.

Given all these circumstances, we consider now conduct comparative research on the measures / actions that, in employment, are being carried out from the local to the European Union, with two objectives:

- Know and study measures and actions in other areas and the results achieved to permit comparison with the local actions of Andalusia / Seville and, most importantly, identify what successful experiences are transferable between different parts of the EU.
- Studying different assessment systems employment actions and know what the most appropriate or that better reflect the impact of actions assessed.

ACTIONS TO BE TAKEN

- Identify a minimum number of institutions / Territories to develop employment plans or actions.

- Develop a classification of employment actions that run in the province and the rest of the territory under investigation and select the key elements to be identified.
- Establish a "road map" of research to develop.
- Study "in situ" of the actions in different territories by the technical project team.
- Creating a web project with specific space to "dump" all experiences / operations assessed.
- Developing the first draft of research about comparative results and identification of two relevant aspects:
 - o The transferability of experiences.
 - o Evaluation systems of different actions.
- Study of the draft for each of the partners and project participants and contributions.
- Finalization of the Research Findings.
- Organization of a final conference to present the results of research and dissemination activities to promote jobs that are performed by local / regional level in the EU.
- Writing the final project report and justification.

RESPONSIBILITY OF PROVINCIAL DE SEVILLA AS PROJECT LEADER AND PARTNERS

LEADER: DIPUTACIÓN DE SEVILLA

Diputación de Sevilla submit it to a call at the regional level, projects financed by the European Social Fund, within a line of support for cooperation projects at the transnational level. This is a need for a commitment of two partners from different EU.

Seville Provincial Council will be responsible for implementing the entire project, pledging to make available to him the necessary human and material resources.

It will also be responsible for managing and justification of funding for this project.

PARTNERS. COMMITMENTS.

Interested partners should sign a letter of commitment to participate in the project. This commitment is not a monetary contribution, only work with project activities and disseminate the results.

Specifically, the partners undertake to:

- Collaborate with project research, providing the necessary information.
- Welcoming the project technicians, in the case of a visitor study, showing the various employment initiatives are decided to study in their respective territories.
- Know and value the shares in favor of employment that are developed in the province of Seville.
- Study and provide feedback and ratings on the draft research findings submitted by the sponsor of the project.
- Participate, as appropriate, in the final conference to be performed.
- To disseminate the project results in their territories and between the institutions with which they collaborate.
